6. Identify the critical attributes of 5 types of decelerations (early, late, variable, prolonged, and spontaneous).
7. Recognize 4 different fetal arrhythmia patterns and their physiologic impact on the fetus.
8. Define normal and abnormal parameters for antepartal test results.
9. Interpret umbilical cord acid-base test results.
10. Interpret 10 fetal monitor tracings and recognize the cause of each.
