## Key Course Objectives

8. Explain physiology, pathophysiology, assessment and care of the newborn during transition to extrauterine life.
9. Apply ethical, legal, and evidence-based practice issues in your own clinical practice to promote patient safety.

### Accreditation and Contact Hours

This offering is in accordance with the continuing education standards of the American Nurses' Credentialing Center Manual for Accreditation as a provider of continuing education in nursing and the Manual for Accreditation.
